A. Product Recommendations for August

The products that we recommend that you consider utilizing during August include:

- <u>Personal Property Securities Register Due Diligence System</u>
 Our suggestion is that you analyze your clients to determine which of them have the following:
 - Stock on consignment
 - Stock stored at someone else's premises
 - Receive progress payment for work services such as trades business working on a major project. This type of business can get into some difficulties with liquidators' preferential payment claims
 - Business assets are hired to other businesses, even businesses within the same group
 - Business assets are located at someone's premises

Our suggestion is that you talk to your clients about undertaking a "Personal Property Securities Register Due Diligence Review" to identify any weaknesses in the business' system relative to the Personal Property Securities Register. Some weaknesses which have been identified include:

- utilizing an "ABN" in the registration when the "ACN" for the company should have been shown;
- mixing up the terminologies "Grantor" and "Grantee"; in both of these cases the business suffered a very high cost!

Crowd-Sourced Funding

Crowd-Sourced Funding Capital Raising can commence from 29 September 2017. This is a good time to start talking to clients - especially clients who are wanting to expand or grow their businesses or clients that have large amounts of loans especially credit card debts and personal borrowings. These businesses may be interested in qualifying as a Crowd-Sourced Funding Company and then attempting to raise capital through crowd-sourced funding so that they can pay out the loans and credit card debts.

We accept that not all of your clients are going to be interested in doing this - some people like owning 100% of their businesses but, some of them could be interested, especially because crowd-sourced funding is not concerned about the age of the business nor the industry that the business operates in- obviously, it is up to the investors to decide whether they are happy with the company's proposals.
